week. We wish them the best of luck for their future debates and thank Mrs Hawkins for training these students.

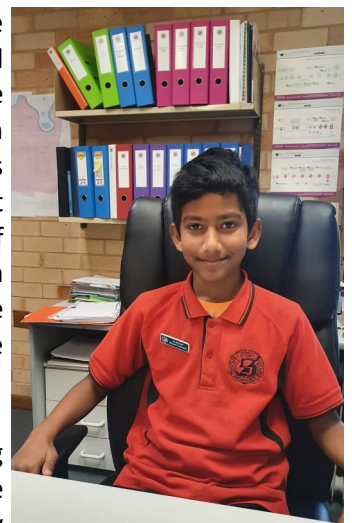
Multicultural Public Speaking
